Messiah Lutheran Council Meeting April 15, 2024

Devotion and Prayer – Mike opened the meeting with prayer.

Call Meeting to Order – The council meeting was called to order by Council President Mike Herzberg at 6:32pm. **Minutes of previous meeting** – The council reviewed the minutes from the March regular council meeting, special council meeting, and council retreat. Corrections were made to the meeting attendance and wording. Dixie motioned to approve the minutes, the motion was seconded by Nancy, and it carried.

April, July, October). If you would like someone to remain on the Weekly Messenger Prayer list or be added, please contact the office.




June Book of the Month

"Danger in the Shadows" by Dee Henderson is the first book in The O'Malley Series.

Introducing the O'Malleys, an inspirational group of seven, all abandoned or orphaned as teens, who have made the choice to become a loyal and committed family. They have chosen their own surname, O'Malley, and have stood by each other through moments of joy and heartache. Their stories are told in CBA bestselling, inspirational romantic suspense novels that rock your heart and restore strength and hope to your spirit. These books are not in Messiah's library but all are available at the local Aurora Library.

"Sara is terrified. She's doing the one thing she cannot afford to do: fall in love with former pro-football player Adam Black, a man everyone knows. Sara's been
